


MUSTEE MODEL 27F DOUBLE COMPARTMENT MODEL 27F LAUNDRY TRAY - FLOOR MOUNTED




- 1. Turn **Laundry Tray** (1) upside down on a clean smooth surface, insert Leg (2) into corner socket using a block of wood or similar pad to protect the end of the leg, strike the pad firmly with a hammer to lock leg securely into tapered socket. Repeat procedure for the remaining three legs. To determine if legs are properly seated into the corner sockets, the gap should be no greater than 1/8". See illustration "A".
- 2. Attach Leveler (3) to each leg using Leveler Screw (4) and Leveler Nut (5). Do not tighten fully until **Laundry Tray** is placed in desired location, at that time, adjust level and tighten screws securely. Holes are provided in each leveler base if anchoring to floor is desired. Anchors are not furnished.
- 3. Insert Strainers (8) into drain holes of **Laundry Tray**, install Sealing Washers (7) on underside of tray and screw strainers into Twin Waste Drain Assembly (6) tighten in place. See illustration "B". **DO NOT** use any putty or thread sealant on strainers or threaded areas of drain fitting. Teflon sealing tape is acceptable.
- 4. Mount faucets (not furnished) to rear ledge which has 2 1" diameter holes in 4" centers. Laundry Tray will also accept single lever or 8" center set faucets, for which mounting holes will have to be drilled. Underside of ledge is marked to show these alternative mounting hole locations. If a faucet block is required for a "top feed" faucet. PN20.600 Molded Faucet Block is available.
- 5. With **Laundry Tray** in desired location make final water supply and sanitary drain connections in full compliance with local code requirements.






MUSTEE DOUBLE COMPARTMENT LAUNDRY TRAY - WALL MOUNTED

ROUGH-IN DIMENSIONS:



Mount Wall Plate (2) at the recommended height shown in Figure 1.

Note: Holes in Wall Plate are positioned to align with studs on 16" center when the center hole of the Wall Plate is located in the middle of a 2" x 4" wall stud. If studs are not evenly spaced, use the 2" x 6" braces as required to mount Wall Plate securely. With top edge of plate level, mark and drill 3/16" diameter holes into studs or braces as required. See Figure 2. (If mounting into cement or concrete, drill holes for five [5] Anchors (10) as shown in Figure 3.) Mount Wall Plate using the Lag Screws (11) supplied. Recheck top edge of plate for level before tightening bolts. Be sure top edge of plate is straight regardless of wall contour; if not, shim as required to obtain this condition.






 Place Laundry Tray (1) on wall plate, mark location of Molded Side Filler (2) & (3) mounting tab holes. Remove Laundry Tray and follow drilling / anchoring procedures as outlined in Step 1. See Figure 1. Insert Strainers (8) into drain holes of Laundry Tray, install Sealing Washers on underside of tray (7) and screw strainers into Twin Waste Drain Asembly (6), tighten in place. See Figure 4. <u>DO NOT</u> use any putty or thread sealant on strainers or threaded areas of drain fitting. Teflon sealing tape (not furfished) is acceptable.






- 4. Mount faucet (not furnished) to rear ledge, which has two 1" (inch) diameter holes on 4" (inch) centers. Laundry Tray will also accept single lever or 8" (inch) Center Set faucet, for which mounting holes will have to be drilled. Under side of ledge is marked to show these alternate mounting hole locations. If a faucet block is required for a "top feed" faucet, PN 20.600 Molded Faucet Block is available.
- Re-hang Laundry Tray on wall plate, be sure to use the 5/16" Diameter Flat Washers (12) under the heads of the 5/16" Lag Screws when anchoring the molded side fillers. The washer will keep the lag screws from digging into and possibly damaging the molded side filler tab.
- Make final water supply and sanitary drain connections in full compliance with local requirements



